



## **Describing company's background, products / services, matchmaking expectations For the IAZ RFP Process**

### **Company Background**

LLC GH Agri Shareholders and Advisory Board Members have been cooperating to establish the high-tech greenhouse facility in Georgia and also were supporting other local private project initiators in establishing their own small-scale production facilities already since 2006.

In 2010 Giorgi Dadiani as the founding Partner and Director of LLC ABG & Profservice Group has received the first support (in the form of grant provision) from the Dutch Embassy PSI program in the amount of 680 EUR in order to implement the first high-tech greenhouse facility in Tbilisi, Georgia for the pot and bedding plants. The project with the total investment volume of 1,75 Mil Eur was successfully implemented by LLC "ABG & Profservice Group" in 2011.

### **Product and services provided by the Company**

LLC GH Agri considers to develop the nursery production facility for producing vegetable seedlings (different varieties of Tomatoes, Cucumbers, Eggplant, Cabbage, Broccoli, Cauliflower, Bell Pepper), for fruits (apples, pear, kiwi), berries (Blueberry, Raspberry, Strawberry), Lettuce and Sweet Potato as a primary production.

As a secondary, additional value creator, LLC GH Agri ("GH Agri") intends to plan seasonal production of Tulips (produce is considered for the 8th of March and white & red stripe varieties for Saint George's day in November).

### **Type of Company we would like to be matched with**

In order to comply to the international standards in greenhouse production and ensure the nursery produce high quality, productivity and yield, GH Agri would like to use the Matchmaking opportunity offered by IAZ with this RFP process, and invite well-established international Agri-input Companies, to support GH Agri initiative, by sharing their technical, technological, commercial, financial and legal expertise to develop the nursery project and support GH Agri in the project development & Agri management in general.

LLC GH Agri would like to consider also the possibility to be matched with local producers of berries with the intention to expand their production by producing e.g. blueberry and other types of highly demanded berry seedlings.

LLC GH Agri would also consider partnership possibilities with potential local and/or international partners to develop the 1.6 ha Nursery greenhouse project for Vegetables, Berries and flowers seedlings with the total investment volume of up to 500,000 EUR.
